5 Peer Editing Strategies That Actually Work For Student ...

Peer editing gives students a chance to write for a broader audience than their instructor, which can encourage better planning about providing context for the topic at hand. Student writing generated with peers in mind stands a better chance of being livelier and more engaging than papers written solely for a removed authority figure.

Enhanced Encouraging Peer Editing - Columbia University

Remind students that the process of producing academic and professional writing generally involves three steps: drafting, revising, and editing. Peer review is often most helpful to student writers when it is utilized between the drafting and revision stages, or after each student has produced a complete draft, but while there is still time to make substantial changes.

Using Peer Review to Help Students Improve Their Writing ...

Have the second student model a peer-edit of the first student's writing. Facilitate as needed as the students work through the peer-editing process. Invite the entire class to discuss the peer-editing process they observed, specifically ways in which the process of editing might help the author and editor improve their writing.

Peer Response and Editing Peer response and editing are processes through which students respond to and provide feedback on their peers' writing. They are not meant to take the place of teacher evaluation, but when incorporated into the writing process, they can be useful learning tools for both the writer and the student providing feedback.
